Be The Change Activity

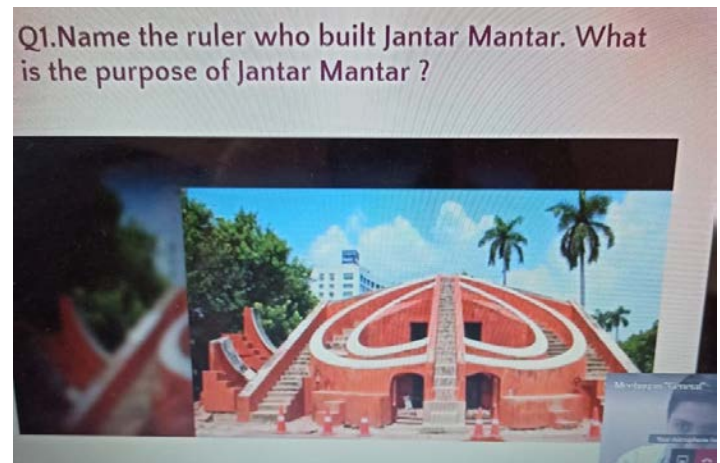
"You must be the change you wish to see in the world."

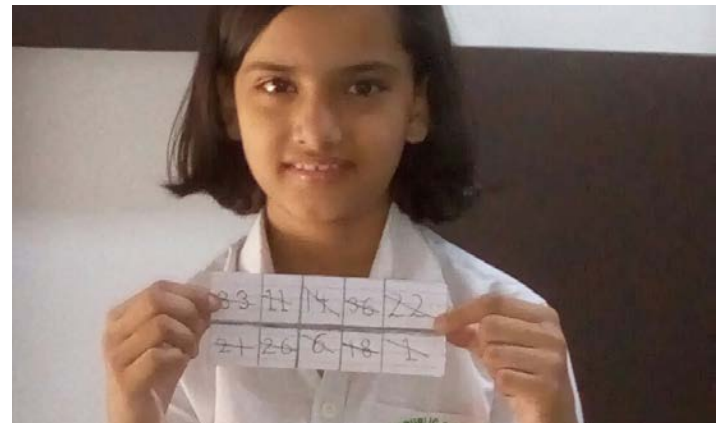

Kanav Jain - Class IV

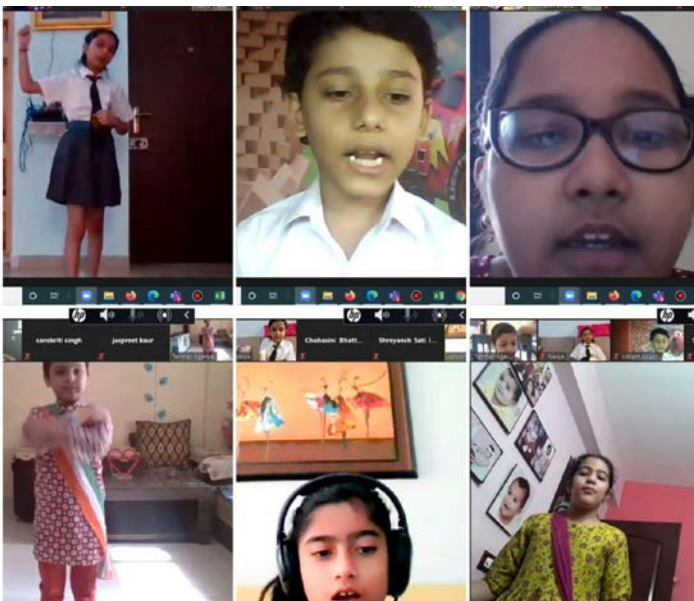
Virtual Tambola Activity
